ADOPTION OF MEETING AGENDA

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

GUEST PRESENTATIONS

- LEE & WHITE Eric Kronberg presented a request for reduction of parking spaces, per zoning requirements. The requested reduction is from 1327 to 566. This application will go before the Board of Zoning Adjustment in City Hall Chambers on Thursday, April 12 at noon. Case Number V-18.42. The Executive Committee voted to recommend with conditions that a walkway be included. A motion was made by Walter Slaton to recommend approval of the parking reduction. Mike Sims seconded the motion. 39 voted to recommend approval; 5 voted no; 5 abstained. Motion passed.
