    - Lee and White property is undergoing major renovations: adding a food hall in the empty parking lot and adding loft office space to existing warehouses. Plans are currently in permitting with the CoA. C
    - onstruction is slated to begin at the end of the summer.
    - Lee and White is asking for an SAP
    - They are proposing a road diet on White Street.
    - Neighbor proposed a pedestrian crosswalk at Peeples and White.
    - There are residences in the long-term master plan for Lee+White, but will not be included in this phase of construction.
    - There will be 850 parking spaces on the property.
    - There will be trees planted around the food hall.
