 - Committee is very busy with new applications.
 - 380 Hopkins Street has been constructed out of compliance with the urban design commission.

- Zoning, Land Use & Code Enforcement
 - o Update on White Street development has been deferred another month.
 - Z-20-69, ordinance in which the city council is attempting to create a designation and definition around short term rentals (less than 31 days) and prohibit them. There has been significant discussion around this topic. WEND has been asked to give a recommendation to NPU-T.
 - Neighbors expressed concern and opposition to the legislation as they rely on Airbnb for income.
 - o The recommendation from the Zoning Committee is not to support the legislation.
